Galatea School has given effect to Te Tiriti o Waitangi through:-

- > Our commitment to honouring a bi-cultural approach in everything we do at our kura
- Ensuring the voice of our local community including iwi representatives AND whānau are actively sought
- Our teaching programmes investigating Te Tiriti o Waitangi and through the learning outcomes in the N.Z histories curriculum.
- > Honouring and acknowledging our local iwi as partners in the education of our tamariki
- Staff have been encouraged to increase their knowledge and use of te reo and tikanga Māori especially in the classroom.
- > Staff PLD has been given to support increased knowledge of te tiriti and local tikanga.
- School systems and routines have been adapted to include the increased use of Whakatauki and Karakia where appropriate for our school and context. This has also been seen in staff meetings etc.
- Partnering with MAC (Māori Achievement Collaborative) to support learning and resources in this space
